

ORDINANCE NO. 97-78 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER FOR ADDITIONAL DRAINAGE WORK IN REGARD TO THE OBERLIN ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to authorize an additional payment to Erie Blacktop, Inc., in the amount of \$5,756.47, for additional drainage work in regard to the Oberlin Road improvement project, in accordance with the change order attached hereto.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to allow for final payment to the contractor and close-out of the project",
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
