CONSTRUCTION TECHNICIAN

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

Assists the Public Works Director and City Engineer in the planning, design, and execution of Public Works construction projects.

The job description is intended merely to illustrate the duties that may be assigned to persons assigned this title. It should not be interpreted to describe all the duties that may be required of persons holding a position assigned this title or to limit the nature and extent of assignments a person may be given.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the supervision and direction of the Director of Public Works and/or the City Engineer.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED:

May supervise Collection and Distribution Operators, Service Maintenance Workers and part-time employees.

JOB DUTIES:

- Obtains information (plats, deeds, records, etc.) for projects.
- Provides accurate measurements and inventory of existing conditions within project limits.
- Assists City Engineer in survey and project layout.
- Observes and inspects construction and/or testing to verify that quantities and procedures used are in accordance with plans and specifications.
 Maintains logs of daily construction activities.
- Revises and prepares final drawings, quantity take-offs, and legal descriptions. Reviews partial estimates to verify amounts billed.
- Follows up with residents to insure problems have been corrected.
- Provides a means for day-to-day communications between City and contractors.
- Attends construction progress meetings.

Page 2 - CONSTRUCTION TECHNICIAN

- Assists in preparation of punch list. Is responsible for follow-up to insure items on punch list are completed.
- Provides information and referral service for residents and property owners affected by the construction project. Assists in the resolution of construction claims.
- Other related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Course work and/or significant experience in construction, estimating, and surveying. Must show mathematical ability, communication skills, and planning and organizing skills. Associates Degree in Engineering Technology or related field preferred.

Knowledge of traffic safety Issues relating to construction zone and construction safety issues.

Ability to read and interpret blueprints, plans, and construction documents.

Basic computer literacy including use of work processing and spreadsheet applications.

UNUSUAL OR SPECIAL WORKING CONDITIONS:

Assists superiors with the resolution of conflicting or incomplete information,

Required to work in severe weather conditions and possible hazardous traffic conditions.

Work hours may be adjusted to match construction schedule.
