

ORDINANCE NO. 98-31 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$18,579.00 FROM  
THE CABLE COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAMMING FUND FOR LOCAL  
CABLE PROGRAMMING EQUIPMENT, EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE  
AND SUPPLIES, AND PROGRAMMING LABOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,  
and the State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby authorized the expenditure of \$18,579.00  
from the City of Oberlin Cable Communications Programming Fund for local  
cable programming equipment, equipment maintenance and supplies, and  
programming labor, and to be used in accordance with the correspondence  
from Cable Co-op, Inc., dated March 3, 1998, and its attachment, a copy being  
attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and said equipment  
to be subject to the lease agreement between the parties as hereinbefore  
approved.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of  
this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were  
adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this  
Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements,  
including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date  
allowed by law.


Enclosed is a Financial Report on revenues and expenses of the fund in the past year and an Allocation Report of what the new release will be spent on.

The purchase of the new Panasonic Edit system will replace the system currently being used to edit locally produced programs. The existing system has had a number of repairs over the last two years, mostly in tape carriage alignments, and has become unreliable in editing and recording "live" programs.

The new system will enable us to take advantage of digital editing capabilities, which more reliable and time efficient edits and time code dubbing for cleaner and more accurate edits.

The old system will be used to make copies of local programs requested by individuals and groups in the community.
