

ORDINANCE NO. 98-33 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS IN REGARD TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN PARKS AND CEMETERY SYSTEM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GLEN SALES OF MOUNT VERNON, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City operates a municipal cemetery and park system; and,

WHEREAS, necessary lawn care equipment is in imminent danger of failure; and,

WHEREAS, the need to purchase lawn care equipment directly affects the parks and cemetery system and represents a real and present emergency arising in connection therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Glen Sales of Mount Vernon, Ohio, for the purchase of two Gravely lawnmowers in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.

SECTION 2. That the immediate need for the purchase of said lawnmowers is hereby declared a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation of the City of Oberlin parks and cemetery system pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the parks and cemetery system",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
