

ORDINANCE NO. 98-71 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DISTRICT 9 PUBLIC WORKS INTEGRATING COMMITTEE FOR ISSUE 11 PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application with the District 9 Public Works Integrating Committee for Issue 11 Public Works Commission funds for the following project to be undertaken in the 1999 program year:

Bridge Repair - Vine Street

SECTION 2. That the City of Oberlin hereby agrees to provide local fund match for said Issue 11 project, if funded by the Ohio Public Works Commission.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"in order to file the application in a timely manner", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
