## ORDINANCE NO. 98-88 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98-74 AC CMS WHICH ACCEPTED THE BID OF UTILITY TRUCK EQUIPMENT CO., OF COLUMBUS, OHIO, FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN AERIAL LIFT SERVICE TRUCK FOR THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT & POWER SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Oberlin City Council previously accepted the bid of Utility Truck Service Co., Of Columbus, Ohio, for the purchase of an aerial lift truck for the Oberlin Municipal Light & Power System; and,

WHEREAS, said bid included the trade-in of a used vehicle, which has recently been destroyed by fire; and,

WHEREAS, due to the destruction of said vehicle it is no longer available for trade-in, and, accordingly, the cash bid price must be modified to reflect the lack of a trade-in.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the contract amount set forth in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 98-74 AC CMS, is hereby amended to read "in an amount not to exceed \$69,026", to reflect the lack of a trade-in vehicle due to recent fire damage.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the pubic peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to amend an accepted bid as soon as possible in order to allow the purchase of a vehicle necessary for the day-to-day operation of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
