

ORDINANCE NO. 99-10 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98-96 AC CMS AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONIES FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1999

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:
