AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98-96 AC CMS, THE 1999 ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION

OF FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. To provide for the anticipated expenses for the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, for the Fiscal year 1999 commencing on January 1, 1999, the following appropriations be and are hereby authorized and allowed as of that effective date:

EMERGENCY HOME REPAIRS	94,000
ACQUISITION	112,500

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"in order to provide for the administration of the CHIP Grant, and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
