

ORDINANCE NO. 99-33 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 96-34 AC CMS, AS AMENDED, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GILLS, GUARD & JOHNSON, INC., OF WILLOUGHBY, OHIO, FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS AT THE OBERLIN WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL PAYMENT FOR ADDITIONAL WORK TO BE PERFORMED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 96-34 AC CMS, as amended, is hereby amended to authorize payment to Gills, Guard & Johnson, Inc., of Willoughby, Ohio, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000, for additional professional services necessary for the tertiary filter system at the Oberlin Waste Water Treatment Plant.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize services necessary to insure the integrity of the City Waste Water Treatment System", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
