

ORDINANCE NO. 99-40 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THERE SHALL BE NO FEE CHARGED BY THE CITY FOR BICYCLE LICENSE REGISTRATION, CARDS, TAGS, AND INSPECTIONS AS REQUIRED BY SECTIONS 373.12, 373.13 AND 373.14 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there shall be no fee charged by the City of Oberlin for bicycle registration, cards, tags and inspections, as required by Sections 373.12, 373.13 and 373.14 of the Codified Ordinances, and Ordinance No. 97-28 AC CMS is hereby amended accordingly.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
