AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH MYERS & ASSOCIATES OF MEDINA, OHIO, FOR ARCHITECTURAL CONSULTANT SERVICES RELATING TO THE PROPOSED EXPANSION OF THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an amendment to the contract with Myers & Associates of Medina, Ohio, for additional architectural consultant services relating to the proposed expansion of the Oberlin Municipal Court and possible architectural changes in the administrative offices of the municipality relating to the court expansion, in accordance with their correspondence of June 7, 1999, and for an additional amount not to exceed \$6,000.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"To proceed with final plans for the expansion of the Oberlin Municipal Court as soon as possible in order to avoid unnecessary construction delays", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
