

ORDINANCE NO. 99-78 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 99-74 AC CMS WHICH AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO AN ENGINE (UNIT 8) AT THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM PLANT TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL PAYMENT TO HANNON ELECTRIC COMPANY OF CANTON, OHIO, FOR ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY REPAIR WORK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths [5/7ths] of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 99-74 AC CMS, which authorized certain emergency repairs to an Engine (Unit 8) of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System Plant by Hannon Electric Company of Canton, Ohio, is hereby amended to authorize compensation for emergency repair work in an amount not to exceed \$62,544 rather than \$44,344.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"To authorize compensation for additional necessary emergency electric plant work in order to ensure economical and consistent electric service to the citizens of Oberlin at the earliest possible date"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
