

RESOLUTION NO. 99-10 CMS

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 2, 1999, THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING THAT A TEMPORARY LEVY OF ONE-FIFTH OF ONE PERCENT (1/5%) BE LEVIED ON INCOME FOR FIVE (5) YEARS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby requests and directs that the Board of Elections of Lorain County, Ohio, place on the ballot at the General Election to be held on November 2, 1999, the question of whether Ordinance No. 99-54 AC CMS, providing that a temporary one-fifth of one percent (1/5%) levy on income for a period of five (5) years, effective January 1, 2000, through December 31, 2004, be passed.

SECTION 2. That the form of the question to be placed on the ballot to be presented to the electors of the City of Oberlin shall be as follows:

A MAJORITY AFFIRMATIVE VOTE IS REQUIRED FOR PASSAGE

Shall Ordinance No. 99-54 AC CMS, providing for a one-fifth of one percent (1/5%) levy on income for the purpose of providing funds for City of Oberlin recreational facilities and associated improvements for five (5) years, effective January 1, 2000, be passed?

_____ For the Income Tax

_____ Against the Income Tax

SECTION 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution, together with a certified copy of Ordinance No. 99-54 AC CMS, with the Board of Elections of Lorain County, Ohio, no later than four o'clock p.m., August 19, 1999.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to submit the Resolution to the Lorain County Board of Elections within the time limitations provided by law"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
