RESOLUTION NO. R99-17 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OBERLIN'S INITIAL SHARE
OF THE COST OF THE CENTRAL LORAIN COUNTY JOINT AMBULANCE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Section 505.71 of the Revised Code permits the board of township trustees of one or more townships and the legislative authority of one or more municipal corporations within or adjoining such townships, by adoption of a joint resolution by a majority of the members of the board of township trustees of each township and the legislative authority of each municipal corporation, to create a joint ambulance district comprising the municipal corporations and all or any portions of the townships as are mutually agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 505.71 of the Revised Code, the City of Oberlin, the Village of Kipton and the Townships of Pittsfield, New Russia and Camden have, by proper legislation previously enacted, approved a Joint Resolution and thereby created the Central Lorain County Joint Ambulance District described therein; and,

WHEREAS, this Council now desires to authorize its initial share of the costs of the Central Lorain County Joint Ambulance District;

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. This Council hereby authorizes the advancement of \$15,000 to the Central Lorain County Joint Ambulance District. The Clerk of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to transmit said monies to the Central Lorain County Joint Ambulance District and to take all other acts and actions required to carry out the deposit of the money herein authorized with the Central Lorain County Joint Ambulance District. Said monies shall be reimbursed to the City upon the approval of a tax levy for the support of said District.


SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective in order to contribute the City's initial share of the costs of the Central Lorain County Joint Ambulance District, which is necessary to better protect

the health and safety of its citizens; wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date permitted by law.
