

RESOLUTION NO. R99-7 CMS

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR 1999
FORMULA ALLOCATION COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
FUNDS FROM THE LORAIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE
PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A LARGE PICNIC SHELTER HOUSE
AT SPRING STREET PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply to the Lorain County Commissioners for 1999 CDBG formula allocation funds in the amount of \$31,450, 15% of which will be allocated to the County for administration of the grant, for the construction of a large picnic shelter house at Spring Street Park for City residents.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"in order to allow for the timely acceptance of said grant funding in accordance with Department of Development procedures"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
