## ORDINANCE NO. 00-111 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF FARABEE CONSTRUCTION, INC., OF HICKMAN, NEBRASKA, FOR THE CIVIL, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL WORK TO INSTALL TWO GENERATORS AT THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT & POWER SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Farabee Construction of Hickman, Nebraska, for the civil, mechanical and electrical work to install two generators at the Oberlin Municipal Light & Power System is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with their bid, and in an amount not to exceed \$745,000.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to enter into contract within time constraints fixed by the competitive bidding process and to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

### CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into as of the 20th day of November, 2000, by Farabee Construction, Inc., Box 188, Hickman, NE 68372, hereinafter called the "Contractor" and the City of Oberlin, Ohio, 289 South Professor St., Oberlin, OH 44074, hereinafter called the "Owner".

#### IT IS AGREED THAT:

ARTICLE I - SCOPE OF WORK: The Contractor shall furnish the necessary labor, equipment and material for the completion of the Work as set forth in the Specifications and Plans identified as "CIVIL, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL WORK TO INSTALL TWO DUAL FUEL TWO DIESEL ENGINE ELECTRICAL GENERATING UNITS AND AUXILIARY EQUIPMENT OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER, OBERLIN, OHIO, PROJECT NO. 00686, 2000".

ARTICLE II - CONTRACT SUM: The Owner shall pay the Contractor for the performance of this Contract according to the following schedule of prices:

#### <u>BID ITEM I</u>

To unload, move, set, align and grout two new Fairbanks-Morse dual fuel diesel engine electrical generating units, each rated 3165 KW; and provide civil, mechanical, and electrical work, for the complete installation of these two units; all for the lump sum price of Seven Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$735,000.00).

## <u>BID ITEM II</u>

To furnish and install new voltage regulators, var/power factor controllers, control power transformers, engine shutdown contact and wiring for Generator No. 5 and No. 6 complete, all for the lump sum price of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

<u>ARTICLE III - COMPLETION TIME</u>: The Contractor shall complete the work as specified by May 31, 2001.
