

ORDINANCE NO. 00 - 46 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 143.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, RELATING TO THE STAFFING REQUIREMENTS OF THE OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 143.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is hereby amended to read as follows:

143.01 DEPARTMENT ESTABLISHED; PERSONNEL

Council hereby establishes a Fire Department in the City. The Fire Department shall consist of the following positions:

Full-Time

1 Chief

1 Assistant Chief

3 Fire Drivers

Part-Time

1 Battalion Chief

6 Lieutenants

17-20 Fire Fighters

If the Battalion Chief or any Lieutenant positions are occupied by a full-time fire driver, the number of fire fighter positions will be adjusted so as to provide at all times a total of twenty-four to twenty-seven part-time personnel.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
