

ORDINANCE NO. 00-48 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "BALLFIELD CONSTRUCTION FUND" FOR
THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio,
five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established a "Ballfield Construction Fund" for the
City of Oberlin, Ohio, to separately account for the revenue and expenditures associated
with the recreational facility:

1. To track donations that may be made by various individuals and
organizations; and
2. To pay for the costs associated with improving the city's recreation
complex by grading, draining, constructing ballfields, and providing
necessary equipment.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting
of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees resulted
in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal
requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the
City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to provide for the receipts and expenses associated with construction and
to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department", and
shall take effect immediately upon passage.
