

## **ORDINANCE NO. 00-99 AC CMS**

### **AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING IOLANDO SALVATORE TALARICO AS CITY AUDITOR FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That Iolando Salvatore Talarico is hereby appointed Auditor for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, effective September 25, 2000, with his employment benefits to include the following:

- a. Salary of \$58,600 per year. Evaluations will be conducted annually.
- b. A \$175 per month vehicle allowance (\$2,100 per year).
- c. All professional organization dues and approved meeting and conference expenses will be paid.
- d. Three weeks of vacation during the first year of service and four weeks in each subsequent year.
- e. Transfer of all accrued sick leave.
- f. All health and dental benefits paid to other City employees; \$50,000 of life insurance; PERS (13.55% paid by City and an additional 5% of salary PERS allowance paid by the City); paid sick leave of fifteen (15) days per calendar year; three (3) paid personal leave days per calendar year; and ten (10) paid holidays per calendar year.
- g. Provide \$1,000,000 of public liability coverage.
- h. No outside consulting work without City Council approval.

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to appoint a City Auditor at the earliest possible date to ensure the continued financial efficiency of the City"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
