

RESOLUTION NO. R00-14 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO FILE A LAWSUIT IN LORAIN COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT AGAINST OBERLIN COMMONS, LLC, TO REQUIRE THE REMOVAL OF AN ILLEGAL SIGN LOCATED ON THE LOT BETWEEN 326 AND 342 WEST LORAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to file a lawsuit in Lorain County Common Pleas Court against Oberlin Commons, LLC, to require the immediate removal of an illegal sign located on the lot located between 326 and 342 West Lorain Street in the City of Oberlin, and to conduct any and all investigations, discovery and other proceedings in said matter as he deems appropriate, all to be charged as extraordinary expense to the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"To require the removal of an illegal sign as soon as possible",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
