

RESOLUTION NO. R00-19 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO PROVIDE OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL WITH 2000 YEAR-END BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS BY JANUARY 16, 2001, FOR COUNCIL APPROVAL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, with the time constraints of processing the year-end payroll (12/29/00) and processing the financial close, it will be extremely difficult to schedule and assemble City Council for approval of the year-end budget adjustments prior to December 31, 2000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Auditor of the City of Oberlin be, and he hereby is, authorized to process 2000 year-end budget adjustments, including but not limited to: appropriation transfers, amendments to the permanent appropriations, cash transfers and cash advances, as needed, for approval by the January 16, 2001 Council Meeting.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Oberlin, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary due to the filing requirement by the Lorain County Auditor's Office (Budget Commission), and this Resolution shall become immediately effective.
