

## ORDINANCE NO. 01-67 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 141.12 (a) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS 18 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT AS AUXILIARY POLICE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That Section 141.12 (a) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

**"141.12 AUXILIARY POLICE UNIT.**

**(a)** Pursuant to Ohio R.C. 737.051, there is hereby authorized and established an auxiliary police unit within the Police Department of the City. *Any person who is eighteen years of age or older shall be eligible for appointment to the auxiliary police unit."*

**SECTION 2.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
