RESOLUTION NO. 01-01 CMS

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR, PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.03, CERTIFY TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE CITY AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THE RENEWAL REPLACEMENT OR COMBINING OF VARIOUS LEVIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, five levies, one for current expenses, two for garbage collection, and two for police pensions, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.25 and 5705.192, were passed by the voters on March 19, 1996 and expired December 31, 2000, with the last collection year being calendar year 2001; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue to pay for current expenses of the general fund, garbage collections and police pensions, renewal or replacements of these levies is needed to be placed on the May 8, 2001, ballot.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. It is necessary, before authorizing levies which are in excess of the 10-mill limit to be put on the ballot, that the Caunty Auditor certify to the City of Oberlin the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a renewal of the 1.2 mills for Current Expenses, a renewal of 0.7 mills for Garbage Collection, a renewal of 2.3 mills for Garbage Collection, a renewal of 0.7 mills for Police Pensions and a renewal of 0.7 mills for Police Pensions, the amount of revenue that would be generated if these same levies were replaced instead of renewed, the amount of revenue that would be generated if the 2.3 mill and 0.7 mill Garbage Levies were combined and replaced at a total of 3.0 mills, and the amount of revenue that would be generated if the 0.9 mill and 0.7 mill Police Pension Levies were combined and replaced at a total of 1.6 mills.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Auditor of Lorain County.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121,22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Resolution be and hereby is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public beace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure that the County Auditor certifies the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated in order to pass legislation for the replacement or renewals of the various levies defalled in Section 1. before the deadline for placing the levies on the ballot,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
