

RESOLUTION NO. 01 - 09 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A RESCUE VEHICLE FOR THE OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin Fire Department provides emergency fire and rescue services to the citizens of the City of Oberlin and desires to replace its rescue vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, through the U.S. Fire Administration, is providing grant funding to fire departments; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin Fire Department has been successful in its bid to obtain additional grant funding through Oberlin College.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for said Assistance to Firefighters Grant funds in the amount of \$60,000 for the acquisition of a replacement fire rescue vehicle for the City of Oberlin Fire Department.

SECTION 2. That, upon approval of grant funding, the City of Oberlin agrees to comply with all conditions for the acceptance of funding, including the provision of at least 10% of total funding for the rescue vehicle.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to allow for the timely application of said grant funding in accordance with the Federal Emergency Management Agency procedures",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
