

## **RESOLUTION NO. R01-18 CMS**

### **A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO MAIN STREET PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO BECOME AN OFFICIAL OHIO MAIN STREET COMMUNITY**

**WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin in Lorain County, State of Ohio, recognizes the importance of downtown as it relates to the economic health and quality of life of the community; and,**

**WHEREAS, the continued improvement, revitalization and development of downtown Oberlin, Ohio is a City goal; and,**

**WHEREAS, the Main Street organization has been formed to stimulate economic development and preservation of downtown Oberlin thereby lessening the burden of municipal government; and,**

**WHEREAS, the Main Street approach to downtown revitalization has generated community-wide interest and support.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:**

**SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio does hereby endorse the submittal of an application to the Ohio Main Street program for the City of Oberlin to become an official Ohio Main Street community.**

**SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.**

**SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.**
