ORDINANCE NO. 02-110 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND THE OPBA AND RELATING TO COMPENSATION FOR PART-TIME POLICE DEPARTMENT DISPATCHERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the attached Settlement Agreement between the City of Oberlin and the OPBA and relating to compensation for Part-Time Police Department Dispatchers is hereby approved, and Article 17 of said Collective Bargaining Agreement is hereby so amended.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio to wit:

"to approve a settlement agreement with a collective bargaining unit as soon as possible in order to resolve a pending labor grievance", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
