

## ORDINANCE NO. 02-123 AC CMS

### AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING VARIOUS FUNDS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That there are hereby established separate funds for

Home Revolving Loan  
Community Development Block Grant-Formula Allocation  
Roadway Development Grant  
Community Development Block Grant-State Economic Development  
Emergency Medical Service Grant  
Main Street Grant  
OPWC Grant 2002 – Maple, N. Pleasant and N. Park

for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, for the purpose of accounting for related revenues and expenses.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to continue, or begin, to account for the associated receipts and expenses of the funds", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
