

ORDINANCE NO. 02-23 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 01-110 AC CMS WHICH
ASSESSED COSTS FOR ABATING NUISANCE CAUSED BY NON-
COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 551.02 OF THE OBERLIN CODIFIED
ORDINANCES AND SECTION 110.3 OF THE PROPERTY MAINTENANCE
CODE FOR THE YEAR 2001**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all member elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 01-110 AC CMS, passed on
December 17, 2001, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. That the amounts above shown are hereby assessed upon the
properties set forth above by permanent parcel number and such assessment
shall be certified for collection upon the 2001 tax duplicate in the same
manner as general taxes."

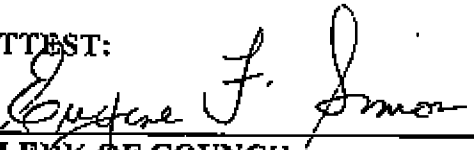
SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of
this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted
in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of
any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to
the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the
Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the
citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to correct the tax duplicate year referred to in prior legislation to allow for
an earlier collection date of certain real estate special assessments", and shall take
effect immediately upon passage.
