## ORDINANCE NO. 02-32 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF SERVICEMASTER BY HORTON OF OBERLIN, OHIO, FOR JANITORIAL SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of ServiceMaster by Horton of Oberlin, Ohio, for janitorial services for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, for a period of twelve (12) months, beginning March 1, 2002 through February 28, 2003, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$32,520, for the year, to be paid in semi-monthly installments of \$1,355.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
