## ORDINANCE NO. 02-42 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 141.12 (b) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, RELATING TO AUXILIARY POLICE TO AUTHORIZE THE CARRYING OF NON-LETHAL WEAPONS AND TO ALLOW PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 141.12 (b) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, relating to auxiliary police is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) The purpose of the unit shall be to assist the Police Department with routine duties and to provide additional assistance and manpower during emergency situations. The auxiliary Police shall not carry firearms. They may carry batons, stun guns, chemical agents and other less-lethal weapons when trained by the Department. The auxiliary police shall not carry weapons, and shall serve without compensation.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
