AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING THE COST FOR ABATING NUISANCE CAUSED BY NON-COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 110.3 OF THE PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND SECTION 715.261 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lordin, State of Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That this Council finds that the Code Administrator of the City of Oberlin has abated nuisance conditions at the following properties, and reported the cost of such abatement in the manner provided by laws, as follows:
