AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 01-106 AC CMS, THE 2002 ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lordin, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. To provide for the anticipated expenses for the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, for the Fiscal Year 2002, commencing on January 1, 2002, the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and allowed as of that effective date, and Ordinance No. 01-106 AC CMS is hereby so amended as detailed in Exhibit A of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"in order to provide for the administration of various departments and to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, and shall take effect immediately upon passage"
