

ORDINANCE NO. 02-96 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VERIZON BPC NORTH/EAST, OF WESTFIELD INDIANA, TO REPLACE THE CURRENT CENTRAX SERVICE WITH ISDN PRI SERVICE FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Verizon BPC North/East, of Westfield Indiana, to replace the current Verizon Centrax service with ISDN PRI service at a cost not to exceed \$1,200 per month for thirty six (36) months.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure that the City has a fully functional and serviceable telephone system as soon as possible in order to conduct municipal operations" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

In previous correspondence I explained that part of replacing our phone system includes switching from the current Centrax line service to ISDN PRI service. We are currently in our last year of a five-year agreement for Centrax service. According to Verizon our current phone system will no longer work with their Centrax service at the end of this year. We need to terminate our Centrax service and replace it with the ISDN PRI service in order to connect the new phone system.

This ordinance will allow the City to enter into a three-year agreement for the new service. The reason the cost is stated in the form of "not to exceed \$1,200 per month" is due to all the individual components that make up that fee that are not yet completely identified. I anticipate the final figure will end up at about \$1,050 per month.

I request that this ordinance be passed on emergency so that Verizon can begin activating the service at the same time that Warwick Communications is installing the phone system. And hopefully the two processes come together, as planned, at the end of September.
