

## RESOLUTION NO. R02-06 CMS

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF EDITH M. WARD, NKA EDITH M. SCHUBERT FOR PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN LAND LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN IN AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 929.02 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Edith M. Ward, nka Edith M. Schubert has recently filed an application with the City of Oberlin to have certain acreage placed in an Agricultural District; and

WHEREAS, City Council has held a public hearing concerning the matter in accordance with Section 929.02 (B) of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the application of Edith M. Ward, nka Edith M. Schubert to place approximately 0.59 acres of real property located in the City of Oberlin and identified by Lorain County Auditor's Parcel Number 09-05-105-000-017, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Applicant by certified mail, return receipt requested, within 5 days of the effective date of this Resolution, and further, to immediately transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to Mark R. Stewart, Lorain County Auditor, all in compliance with Section 929.02 (B) of the Ohio Revised Code.



It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, to wit:

"to allow the timely filing of an agricultural district application within the time limitations provided by Ohio law," and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
