## RESOLUTION NO. R02-10 CMS

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 5, 2002, THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING THAT THE TEMPORARY ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2%) LEVY ON INCOME APPROVED IN 1983 AND 1993 AND 1998, BE REPLACED BY A PERMANENT ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2%) LEVY ON INCOME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby requests and directs that the Board of Elections of Lorain County, Ohio, place on the ballot at the General Election to be held on November 5, 2002, the question of whether Ordinance No. 02-66 AC CMS, providing that the temporary one-half of one percent (1/2%) levy on income approved in 1983 and renewed in 1988 and 1993 and 1998, be replaced with a permanent one-half of one percent (1/2%) levy on income, effective January 1, 2004, be passed.

SECTION 2. That the form of the question to be placed on the ballot to be presented to the electors of the City of Oberlin shall be as follows:

## A MAJORITY AFFIRMATIVE VOTE IS REQUIRED FOR PASSAGE

Shall Ordinance No. 02-66 AC CMS, providing for the replacement of the temporary one-half of one percent (1/2%) levy on income with a permanent one-half of one percent (1/2%) levy on income for the purpose of providing money for capital improvements and operating expenses for the City of Oberlin, effective January 1, 2004, be passed?

SECTION 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution, together with a certified copy of Ordinance No. 02-66 AC CMS with the Board of Elections of Lorain County, Ohio, no later than four o'clock p.m. August 22, 2002.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to submit this Resolution to the Lorain County Board of Elections within the time limitations provided by law"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
