

RESOLUTION NO. R02-16 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO REPRESENT THE CITY IN ALL PROCEEDINGS RELATING TO THE REQUEST OF THE LORCO RURAL WASTEWATER DISTRICT TO MODIFY THE CITY OF OBERLIN'S FACILITY PLANNING AREA AS SET FORTH IN THE NOACA CLEAN WATER 2000 (208 WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR NORTHEAST OHIO) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to represent the City of Oberlin in any and all proceedings related to the request of the LORCO Rural Wastewater District to modify the current Facility Planning Area of the City of Oberlin as set forth in the NOACA Clean Water 2000 (208 Water Quality Management Plan for Northeast Ohio) and to take such action and file such Petitions, Appeals and Complaints that he deems to be in the best interests of the City of Oberlin, all to be charged as extraordinary expense.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to ensure that the interests of the City in pending proceedings are protected in a timely manner", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
