

## RESOLUTION NO. R02-17 CMS

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO ENGAGE THE SERVICES OF ATTORNEY ABRAHAM CANTOR AS SPECIAL COUNSEL TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to retain the services of Attorney Abraham Cantor of Concord, Ohio, as Special Counsel to the City of Oberlin to facilitate the collection of delinquent municipal utility accounts, to be paid at the rate of \$150. per hour, plus reimbursement for any advancements and expenses incurred on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to facilitate the collection of delinquent utility accounts as soon as possible",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
