

RESOLUTION NO. 02-18 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT (CLG) GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OHIO HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has applied for and has received "Certified Local Government" status through the Ohio Historic Preservation Office in recognition of its historic preservation program; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Historic Preservation Office has recently advised the City that matching funding on a competitive basis is available to "Certified Local Governments" through its "Grant Program" to continue its preservation activities; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission has used funds budgeted for the Commission to pursue the inventorying of historic properties in the past through contracts with the Oberlin Historic and Preservation Organization; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission recommends that the City apply for funding under the "CLG Grant Program", and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desires to participate in the "CLG Grant Program" in order to receive funds to continue the inventorying of historic properties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has the authority to apply for financial assistance, to enter into a contract with the Ohio Historic Preservation Office and to administer funds received through the "CLG Grant Program."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for funding under the "Certified Local Government Grant Program" offered by the Ohio Historic Preservation Office to continue the inventorying of historic properties.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant award from the Ohio Historic Preservation Office for local historical preservation activities.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"in order to allow for the timely application for said Certified Local Government Grant program funding in accordance with all applicable procedures"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
