

Dear Darryl,

I received your request for an extension of the completion time for the construction of Phase III of the Oberlin Reserve subdivision. Phase II was accepted for public maintenance by Ordinauce 03-20, enacted on March 3, 2003. As I understand it, construction for Phase III has not yet begun. In accordance with the Subdivision Construction Agreement dated June 4, 2002 between Norris Builders, Inc. and the City of Oberlin, the City Manager may extend the completion deadline for an additional 365 days. The relevant section is excerpted below

#### Section V. Completion Time:

The SUBDIVIDER-DEVELOPER agrees to complete all required improvements listed in Section IV within 365 consecutive days (1 Year) unless said completion is extended in writing for good cause by the Oberlin City Manager. Such extension or extensions shall not exceed 365 additional days.

This letter will constitute my written extension of the completion date for the Oberlin Reserve Subdivision, Phase III until June 4, 2004. If an additional extension is necessary to complete the required improvements in their entirety prior to June 4, 2004, councilmatic action will be required.
