BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Erie Blacktop, Inc., of Sandusky, Ohio, for utility improvements and replacement on Reamer Place and South Street in the City of Oberlin, being the lowest and best bid received, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with their bid, and in an amount not to exceed \$261,873.50.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

 - (A) This Contract, together with the Contractor's and Surety's performance and payment bonds for the Project, if any, constitute the entire and exclusive agreements between the parties well reference to the Project and said Contract supersedes any and all prior discussions communications, representations, understandings, acgorithments, or agreements.
 - (B) Anything their may be required, implied or inferred by the documents which make up this Contract, or any one or more of them, shall be provided by the Contractor for the Contract Price;
 - (C) Nothing contained in this Contract shall create, nor be interpreted to create, privity or any other relationship whatsoever between the City and any person except the Contractor.
 - (D) When a word, term, or phrase is used in this Confract it shall be interpreted or construct first, as defined acroin; second, if not desined, according to its generally accepted meaning in the construction industry; and third, if there is no generally accepted meaning in the construction industry, according to its common and customary usage,
 - (E) The words "melades", "includes", or "nactuding", as used in this Contract, shall be deemed to be followed by the phrase, "without limitation",
 - (F) The specification herein of any ant, failure, refusal, omission, event, occurrence or condition as constituting a material breach of this Cuntract shall not imply that any other, non-specified act, failure, refusal, omission, event, occurrence or condition shall be deemed not to constitute a material breach of this Contract,
 - The Contractor shall have a continuing duty to read, examine review, compare and contrast each of the documents which make up this Contract shop drawings, and other subminal and shall give written notice to the Lity and the Engineer of any conflict, ambiguity error or ornission which the Contractor may find with respect to these dincurrents before proceeding with the affected work. HOWEVER, THE City MAKES NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY OF ANY NATURE WHATSOEVER TO THE CONTRACTOR CONCERNING SUCH DOCUMENTS. The Contractor again hereby acknowledges and represents that it has received reviewed and carefully examined such documents, has found then to be complete, accurate, idequate, consistent, coordinated and sufficient for construction, and that the Contractor has not does not, and will not rely upon any representations or warranties by the City concerning such documents, as no such representations or warranties have been or are acreby made;
 - (H) In the event of any conflict, discrepancy, or inconsistency among any of the documents which make up this Contract, the following shall control

- 12 The Contractor shall perform all of the work required, implied or reasonably inferable from this Contract including, but not limited to, the following
 - (A) Construction of the Project:

 - (C) The provision or furnishing, and prompt payment therefor, of labor, supervision, services, materials, supplies equipment, fixtures, appliances, facilities, tools, transportation, storage power, fiel, heat, light, cuoling, or other utilities, required for construction and all accessory building permits and other permits required for the construction of the Project;

- (D) Neither payment to the Contractor, will rather unfithe Project for any purpose by the City, nor any other act or omission by the City shall be interpreted or construct as an acceptance of any work of the Contractor not strictly in compliance with this Contract
- (b) Prior to being entitled to receive final payment, and as a condition precedent thereto, the Contractor shall runnish the City, in the form and manner required by City, if any, with a crept to the Engineer:

If the City repeatedly fails to perform at material obligations to the Contractor for a period of thirty (30) days after receiving written notice from the Contractor in as intent to terminate hereunder, the contractor may terminate performance under this Contractor shall be entitled to recover from the City and the City and the City are through the City had terminated the Contractor's performance under this Contract for convenience

14 City's Right to Suspend Cuntractor's Performance

The City shall have the right at any time to direct the Contractor to suspend its performance, or any designated part thereof, for any reason whatsoever, or without reason, for a cumulative period of up to extender days. If any such suspension is directed by the City, the Contractor shall attimediately comply with same.

In the event the City directs a suspension of performance under this Penagrapa , through no fault of the Contractor, the City shall pay the Contractor as full compensation for such suspension the Contractor's reasonable costs, actually incurred and paid, of

- (A) demobilization and remobilization, including such costs paid to subcontractors
- (B) preserving and protecting work is place;
- (C) storage of materials or equipment purchased for the Project, including insurance thereon,
- (D) performing in a later, or during a longer, time frame than that contemplated by this Contract.
- 15 Termination by the City

The Circ, may terminate this Chatract in accordance with the following terms and conditions.

- (A) The City may, for any reason whatsoever, terminate performance under this Contract by the Contractor for convenience. The City shall give written notice of such termination to the Contractor specifying when termination becomes effective. The Contractor shall mean no further obligations in connection with the work and the Contractor shall stop work when such termination becomes effective. The Contractor shall asso terminate outstanding orders and whenmingly. The Contractor shall actual the habilities and claims arising out of the termination of subcontracts and orders. The Contractor shall actual the Contractor to assign the Contractor's right, title and interest under termination orders or subcontracts to the City or its designed. The Contractor shall transfer title and deliver to the City such compliced or partially completed work and materials, equipment parts, fixtures, information and Contract rights as the Contractor has. When terminated for convenience, the Contractor shall be compensated as follows.
 - (1) The Contractor shall subroit a termination clear to the City and the Engineer specifying the amounts due because of the termination to convenience together with costs, pricing or other data required by the City or the Engineer. If the Contractor fails to file a termination clear, within one (1) year from the effective date of termination, the City shall pay the Contractor, an amount derived in accordance with Subparagraps (3) below.
 - (2) The City and the Contractor may agree to the compensation, if any, due to the Contractor hereunder;

- Absent agreement to the amount due to the Contractor, the City shall pay the Contractor the following amounts
 - (a) Contract prices for labor, materials, equipment and other services accepted under this Contract,
 - (b) Reasonable costs incurred in preparing to perform and in performing the terminated portion of the work, and in terminating the Contractor's performance, plus a fair and reasonable allowance for direct jobsite overhead and profit thereon (such profit shall not include anticipated profit or nonsequential damages) provides however, that if it appears that the Contractor would have not profited or would have sustained a loss if the entire? Ontract would have been completed, no profit shall be allowed or included and the amount of compensation shall be reduced to reflect the anticipated rate of loss if any,
- (e) Reasonable costs of settling and paying claims arrang out of the termination of subcontracts or orders pursuant to Subparagraph (A) of this Paragraph. These costs shall not include amounts paid in accordance with other provisions hereof.

The total sum to be paid the Contractor shad not exceed the total Contract Price, as properly adjusted, reduced by the amount of payments otherwise made, and shall in no event include duplication of payment.

(B) If the Contractor does not perform the work, or, any part thereof, in a timely manner, supply adequate labor supervisory personnel or proper equipment or materials, or if it fails to imply discharge its obtigations for labor, equipment and materials or processes to disabely applicable law or otherwise commits a violation of a material provision of this Contract, then the City, in addition to any other rights it may have against the Contraction of others, may terminate the performance of the Contraction assume possession of the Project site and of all materials and equipment at the site and may complete the work. In such case, the Contractor shall not be paid for their until the work is complete. After final completion has been achieved if any portion of the Contract Price as it may be modified hereunder, remains after the cost to the City of completing the work, including all justs and expenses of every nature incurred, has been deducted by the City, such remainder shall belong to the Contractor. Otherwise, the Contractor shall pay and make while the City for such cost. This obligation for payment shall survive the termination of the Contractor.

In the event the employment of the Custractor is terminated by the City for cause pursuant to this Subparagraph B) and it is sub-equently determined by a Court of competent jurisdiction that such termination was without cause, such termination shall thereup in be deemed a Termination for Convenience under Subparagraph A) and the provisions of Subparagraph (A) shall apply
