ORDINANCE NO. 03-83 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS IN REGARD TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER SYSTEM (OMLPS) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO HIRE HANNON ELECTRIC COMPANY TO REPAIR THE ALTERNATOR ON ENGINE #1 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City operates a municipal Light and Power System; and

WHEREAS, the City has discovered damage to the alternator on Engine #1 (1948 Fairbanks-Morse Opposed Piston) at the power plant during the widespread power outage of August 14, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the loss of the alternator renders engine #1 unusable until the alternator is repaired which will require a rewind of the stator and refurbishment of the rotor; and

WHEREAS, the loss of use of engine #1 presents the potential for loss of revenues from peak-shaving operations, the loss of generation to honor peak-shaving contracts, and the loss of black-start capabilities, which represents a real and present emergency arising in connection with said system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Hannon Electric Company of Canton, Ohio, for the repair of the alternator on Engine #1 in an amount not to exceed \$48,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the immediate need for said work is hereby declared a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation of the City of Oberlin's Municipal Light and Power System pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operations of a municipal department to wit:

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"to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System Plant",

and shall take effect Immediately upon passage.
