

ORDINANCE NO. 03-88 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 02-114 AC CMS RELATING TO COMPENSATION FOR THE CITY SOLICITOR AND CITY PROSECUTOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 02-114 AC CMS is hereby
amended as follows:

POSITION CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLAN

<u>POSITION TITLE</u>	<u>PART-TIME AND FIXED ROLE POSITIONS</u>
Prosecutor	The salary of the Prosecutor shall be set by the City Solicitor. The Prosecutor shall also be entitled to extraordinary compensation for work relating to jury trials and appeals, as determined by the City Solicitor, plus City health benefits and all other compensation and benefits applicable to the position.
Solicitor	\$37,325 per year and \$100 per hour for extraordinary legal services, plus City health benefits and all other compensation and benefits applicable to the position.

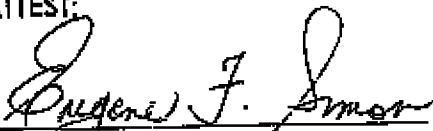
SECTION 2. That the salary adjustment for the Solicitor shall become effective as of August 1, 2003.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
