

ORDINANCE NO. 05-08 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER'S DEPENDENTS BOARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 146 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 146, there is hereby established the Volunteer Firefighter's Dependents Board for the City.

SECTION 2. The Volunteer Firefighter's Dependents Board shall consist of five members who shall be chosen as follows:

- (a)** Two members shall be elected by Council.
- (b)** Two members shall be elected by the Fire Department.
- (c)** One member shall be elected by the Board members elected pursuant to subparagraphs (a) and (b) hereof. Such member must be an elector of the City but may not be a public employee or a member of Council or of the Fire Department.

SECTION 3. Election of Board members set forth in Sections (2)(a) and (2)(b) hereof shall be held on the first Monday in December. Election under Section (2)(c) hereof shall be held on or before the second Monday of December. Each Board member shall serve for a one-year term commencing on January 1 following his/her election.

SECTION 4. The Volunteer Firefighter's Dependents Board shall have authority to make all necessary rules and regulations for the handling and processing of claims which may be submitted to it and shall perform all such other duties as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this chapter and the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 146.

SECTION 5. Members of the Volunteer Firefighter's Dependents Board shall serve without compensation. The City shall provide the necessary meeting place, stationery, postage and supplies necessary for the efficient conduct of the business of the Board.

SECTION 6. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

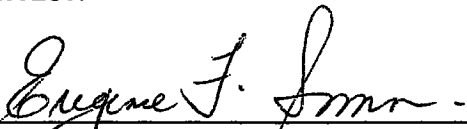
SECTION 7. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to establish a Volunteer Firefighter's Dependents Board as soon as possible in order to comply with the Ohio Revised Code at the earliest possible date",

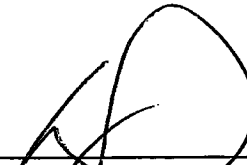
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

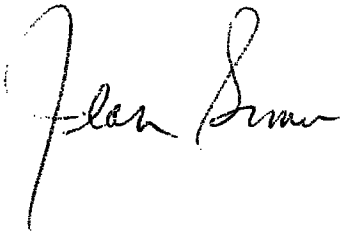
