That certain proposed public permanent improvements, including water lines, sanitary sewer lines, storm sewer lines and street lighting system, for the WalMart Development, as recorded in Vol. 74, Pages 37-39, of the Lorain County Record of Plats, be and the same are hereby accepted by the City of Oberlin for ownership, operation, and maintenance, pursuant to Section 1311.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to allow for timely compliance with the terms of the Development Construction Agreement", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

Walmart: Acceptance of certain Public Improvements

On October 9, 2006 City Council passed Ordinance 06-83 which amended the Development Construction Agreement between the City and Walmart. This amendment allowed Walmart to open on October 9th and extended the time to complete all required items to December 31, 2006.

These various items are now complete and staff recommends acceptance of the public improvements to the water, sanitary sewer, storm sewer and electrical systems. This proposed acceptance does not include the 'Principal Access Drive' as it has not been the City's intent to accept the street until it is connected to the north.


Punch list repairs and/or improvements to the water, sanitary sewer and electrical systems are now completed to the satisfaction of the Public Works Department and OMLPS.

On the administrative side, the Development Construction Agreement requires certain documentation prior to acceptance of the public improvements by City Council. This includes:

- "waivers of lien executed by all suppliers, contractors, and subcontractors..."
- "The Developer's professional engineer...shall...certify to the City Manager that all Public Improvements...have been constructed as required by this Agreement..."
- The provision of 'as-built' drawings, both in hard copy and in electronic format
- "a maintenance guarantee shall be posted...in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the costs of the Public Improvements"
- "the Developer shall petition the City in writing for acceptance of the Public Improvements except the Principal Access Drive."

These administrative items are now completed. Waivers of Lien, in forms approved by Mr. Severs, have been provided by the contractor and sub-contractors. A copy of the certification of the improvements, prepared and stamped by Lynn Miggins, PE and president of KS Associates (attached) has been provided. Ms. Miggins has also prepared the 'petition' for acceptance (attached). I have received the as-built drawings. The Performance Guarantee, a letter of credit, has been amended to the revised amount of the Maintenance Guarantee, a total of \$53,950, representing 10% of the value of the public improvements proposed to be accepted.

Ms. Miggins is planning to attend City Council meeting on December 18th to assist in answering any questions which may arise. Please let me know if you have any questions in the interim.
