ORDINANCE NO. 06-35 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF YORK BUILDING MAINTENANCE, INC., OF CLEVELAND, OHIO, FOR JANITORIAL SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of York Building Maintenance, Inc., of Cleveland, Ohio, for janitorial services for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, for a period of 36-months, beginning May 1, 2006 through April 30, 2009, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$99,000.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to enter into a contract in a timely fashion so as to avoid an interruption in janitorial service", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
