ORDINANCE NO. 06-63 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 06-34 AC CMS, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JIM'S ELECTRIC, INC., OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO, FOR ELECTRIC WORK FOR THE GENERAL MAINTENANCE DIVISION SERVICE COMPLEX TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 06-34 AC CMS, which authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Jim's Electric, Inc., of North Ridgeville, Ohio, for electric work for the General Maintenance Division Service Complex, is hereby amended to authorize construction contract contingency funds of \$6,157.50, with a new increased contract amount not to exceed \$416,657.50.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to authorize additional contract funds at the earliest possible date in order to avoid construction delays" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
