SWIMMING POOL REQUIREMENTS & PERMIT

- Fees:** Above-Ground Pool - \$50
 In-Ground Pool - \$75 ****must contact Building Department to schedule electrical inspection****
 Commercial/Multi-Fam. Pool - \$200 ****must contact Building department for requirements**

Attach w/application: a property survey or site plan showing placement of pool on property and distance from the property lines and residence.

Access to residential pools shall be restricted by one of the following means:

- A. Walls or fencing not less than 4 feet high and completely surrounding the pool and deck area, with the exception of self-closing and latching gates and doors capable of being locked.
- B. Other means not less than 4 feet high and deemed impenetrable by the enforcing authority at the time of construction and completely surrounding the pool and deck area when the pool is not in use.
- C. A combination of clauses A and B that completely surrounds the pool and deck with the exception of self-closing and latching gates and doors which are capable of being locked. This applies to clauses A and B and this clause only.
- D. Power safety pool cover that: (re: in-ground)
 - 1. Provides a continuous connection between the cover and the deck , so as to prohibit access to the pool when the cover is completely drawn over the pool
 - 2. Is mechanically operated so that the cover cannot be drawn open or retreated without the use of a key, switch and key, or touch pad with a personal access code.
 - 3. Is installed with track, rollers, rails, guides or other accessories necessary to accomplish items in the two aforementioned safety points.

Lifesaving equipment: Every residential swimming pool shall be installed with **NO LESS** than the following lifesaving equipment:

- A. A ring or throwing buoy fitted with 40 feet of 1/4 inch diameter line.
- B. A pole not less than 12 feet in length.
- C. Access to a telephone.

Electrical connection: Electrical service shall be in accordance with the 2008 Indiana Electrical Code.

- A. Only connected to a ground fault interrupter circuit (GFIC). No extension cords may be used.
- B. No pool shall be installed below overhead or above underground electric wires.
- C. An electric permit will be required for any new permanent electrical connection devices or wiring.
