RETURNAfrica operates two luxury camps, a bush house and walking trails at Pafuri in the north of the Kruger Park. We also offer a booking service to selected lodges that have community ownership at their core. Our portfolio includes properties in South Africa, Mozambique and Namibia.

RETURNPafuri

Our facilities are situated on Makuleke land in the north of the Kruger Park. The area, also known as Pafuri, is one of the jewels of Africa, blessed with prodigious biodiversity, splendid scenery, abundant wildlife and a world-renowned birding list.

Our 265km² concession lies in a triangle flanked by the Limpopo to the north and the Luvuvhu to the south, two great but very different African rivers. Between them, they embrace a spectacular and varied landscape, with mountains and gorges in the west giving way to kopjes, floodplains, pans, baobabs and woodlands – including a magical forest of fever trees – in the east. The land, particularly the low-lying floodplains near the confluence, offer abundant feeding grounds that draw great herds of elephant, buffalo and other game, especially when the surrounding bush lies parched in the months before the arrival of the rains.

There are three main elements that make up the **RETURNPafuri** experience: Pafuri Walking Trails, Pafuri Camp and Baobab Hill Bush House.



ACTIVITIES

We offer guided game drives, walks, fly-fishing in the Luvuvhu and mountain-bike excursions (either with your own bike or one of ours). Guests staying at Baobab Hill can also self-drive on the Kruger roads south of the Luvuvhu.

PAFURI WALKING TRAILS

Two trails of 8 guests each

This popular 3-night, 4-day trail offers you the opportunity to experience one of the most remote and spectacular parts of the Kruger Park on foot. Accompanied by highly experienced field guides, you will explore a landscape that is as vast as it is quintessentially African. You will focus on the little things but you will also experience the rush of adrenaline when you chance upon one of the Big Five. Home base is a rustic but comfortable bush camp near the banks of the river where we serve hearty food and drink in a setting that allows you a close-up experience of untamed Africa. *Pafuri Walking Trails run from April to November*

PAFURI CAMP

19 luxury safari tents (sleeping between 2 and 4 people)

Situated on the banks of the Luvuvhu, Pafuri Camp is the RETURNAfrica flagship. The en-suite luxury tents - 5 of which are family units sleeping up to 4 persons - all have sweeping views over the Luvuvhu. Lounge on your stoep and watch the endlessly varying spectacle of life drawn to banks of the river. Or lie in bed and listen to the rustle and cry of the bush. The communal area offers all the comforts including al fresco dining, one of Africa's great bush bars and a swimming pool. This is a full-service camp providing breakfast, lunch, high tea & dinner. We don't subscribe to the staid 2 game drives a day philosophy. Instead, guests have a choice of activities including guided walks, mountain bike excursions, fly-fishing and, of course, open vehicle drives.

This camp is currently being renovated & will be relaunched in Sept 2015

BAOBAB HILL BUSH HOUSE

The old section ranger's house, perfect for groups and/or families (sleeps 8)

Perched on a secluded, baobab-studded hill just north of the Luvuvhu, Baobab Hill is the old Pafuri ranger's station. This rustic homestead is the ideal accommodation for small groups or families of up to eight people. It has four bedrooms with a home kitchen, open plan lounge, dining area and wrap-around stoep – perfect for sundowners or dinners in the early evenings. There is a private swimming pool, and the property is fenced – offering a child-friendly environment. Baobab Hill is self-catering but a local in-house chef is on call to assist at mealtimes. Guests may also use the bush bar and restaurant at Pafuri Camp.
