### Maldives – Jumeirah Dhevanafushi

The Maldives – one of the most exclusive destinations on the planet – has to be the top choice for a once-in-a-lifetime escape. Jumeirah Dhevanafushi has won multiple awards since it opened five years ago and boasts some of the largest over water villas in the Maldives. The island itself is small (takes around 10 minutes to stroll around the circumference), but what it lacks for in quantity, it makes up for in quality – whether it's the spa treatments, the cuisine or the incredible efficiency of the staff.



### Mauritius – Heritage Le Telfair

Mauritius is one of the more pocket-friendly places to visit for UK residents at the moment; it's somewhere your pound goes further – meaning you can luxuriate in five-star splendour at Heritage Le Telfair for less than you might expect, especially if you travel in low season. The Mauritian climate is good year round, meaning there's not really a bad time to visit. There's also a minimal time difference, so no jet-lag.



### Barbados – The House

This hip hotel is a great choice for foodies. Many of Barbados' best restaurants are within easy reach, and right next door is Daphne's (the beachside counterpart to the famous Kensington haunt) – who also provide the all-day menu for The House. It's adults-only, so there's a calm atmosphere that makes it easy to relax whilst being spoilt rotten by the five-star service that everyone comes home raving about.
