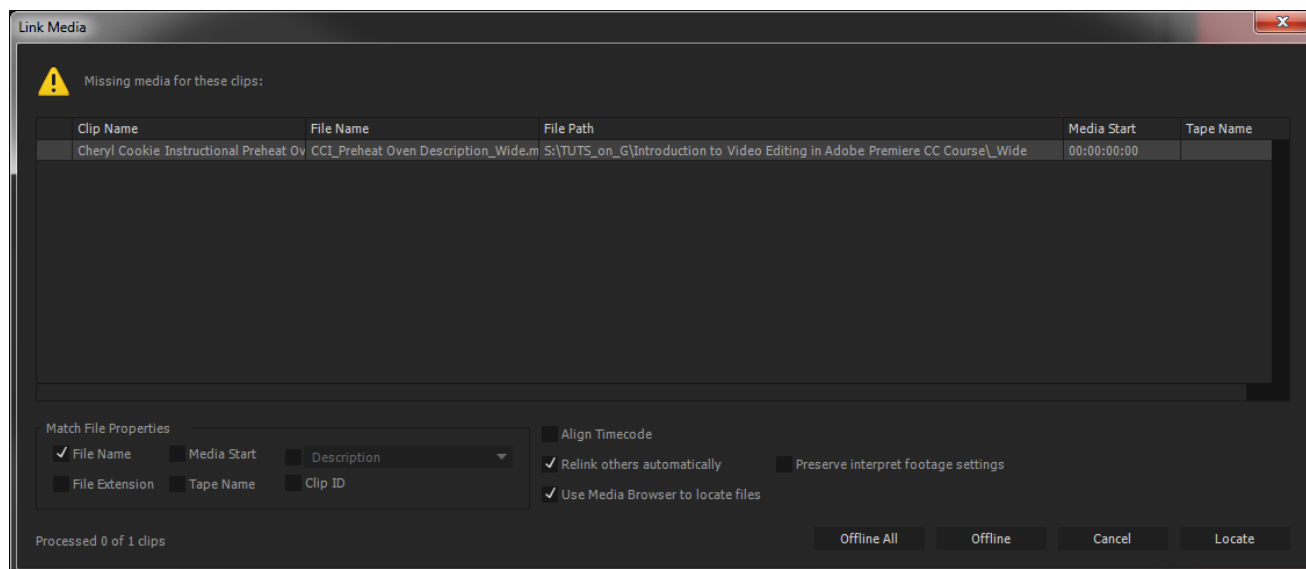
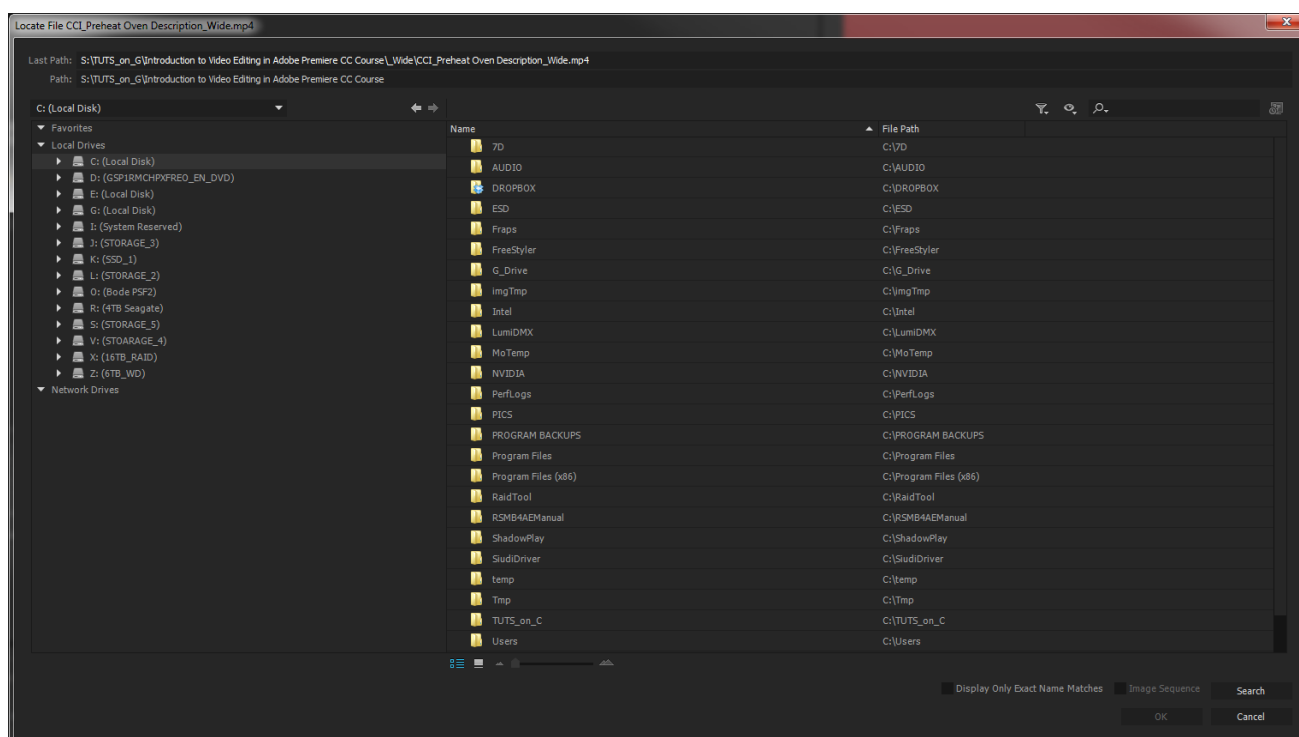


Thanks for checking out this course! If you are trying to use the demo Premiere Pro project file, you may have to point Premiere to where the sample video files are located. This is because the Premiere project will be expecting the files to be in a different location. When the project opens, you will probably get a window that pops up and it looks like this.



All you have to do is click the Locate button in the bottom right corner. Then you can navigate to where the demo files are located and select the file that matches the name. To make it easier, you can click the display Only Exact Name Matches button on the bottom right.



If you can't remember where you placed the demo files or where they downloaded to, don't worry, Premiere can search for you. Click the display Only Exact Name Matches button on the bottom right, select the drive you want it to search in the left panel (start with your main OS drive), and click Search. Premiere Pro is smart and will locate the file very quickly.
